We may collect and process the following types of personal data:

3. How we use your information

We use your personal data for:

4. Lawful basis for processing

- Payment processors and logistics providers, where necessary to fulfil orders.
- Professional advisers (lawyers, accountants, auditors).
- Authorities if required by law.

- Marketing cookies (HubSpot) to personalise content and track engagement with our campaigns.

1. What are cookies?

2. Types of cookies we use

- Essential cookies
